TERMS & CONDITIONS

Exhibiting in RRRTAG Curated Exhibitions

1. RRRTAG is solely responsible for the curating of works for display.
2. Entries in any medium should address the stated theme of the exhibition.
3. Work accepted for exhibition must be delivered to the Gallery and unsold work collected on the dates specified on the '**Application & Agreement to Exhibit**' form.
4. Alternative arrangements for delivery and/or collection may be negotiated. As storage space is limited no responsibility will be taken by RRRTAG for work not collected by the negotiated date.
5. Artworks must be ready to hang with wires and specific details for display of works other than paintings/photographs. A small number of plinths are available for 3D work.
6. A lockable glass cabinet is available to display smaller, more fragile works.
7. Each piece of Artwork must have a securely attached label with the artist's name, title of the work, sale price and contact number.
8. RRRTAG reserves the right to exclude works from exhibition it considers inappropriate in content or of an unacceptable standard or quality in workmanship.
9. All Artworks must be for sale unless with prior consent from the Gallery.
10. Payments for artwork sold will be paid to RRRTAG. A gallery commission of 33% applies to all works. Artists must factor this into their sale price. Prices should be realistic in terms of the local market.
11. The proceeds of sales (*less Gallery commission*) will be paid directly into exhibitors accounts within two weeks of the closing of the exhibition.
12. All works must remain in the exhibition space (unless otherwise agreed) until 4pm on the final day of the exhibition.
13. Insurance of work is the responsibility of the Artist. RRRG takes all reasonable care but no responsibility for damage or loss of work while at the Gallery.
14. RRRG reserves the right to use photographs of work for publicity, advertising and promotional purposes.
15. An Exhibition Opening is usually held between 6.30 and 8pm on the Friday preceding the start of each exhibition. Artists are strongly encouraged to attend these events - it is a fabulous opportunity to mingle with/meet other Artists and community members in a relaxed social setting.
16. Exhibitors are asked to assist with Gallery supervision during the exhibition. RRRTAG is run entirely by volunteers and to ensure sustainability we endeavor to spread the workload. A roster is set up for each exhibition and a member of the Gallery committee is available to assist first time volunteers with Gallery procedures. **Your assistance in this area would be greatly appreciated.**

What RRRTAG Provides:

1. Curation and hanging of the exhibition.
2. Organization of advertising and promotion - invitations, newspaper advertising, design and distribution of posters etc.
3. Design, preparation and printing of catalogues.
4. An Exhibition Opening. Wine, beer, champagne and soft drinks are sold at the bar and a selection of hot and cold finger food is prepared and served.
5. Management and recording of sales.
6. Email of exhibition details and an Invitation to the Exhibition Opening to our extensive mailing list.
7. Listing of the exhibition on our website.
