Red Rock Regional Theatre and Gallery Inc. (RRRTAG) is a state-of-the-art theatre/ performance and art space situated on the former St David's Church site in Cororooke, Western Victoria. It was founded in July 2011 by Andrew and Mary Beale, who generously handed over the use of the site to the community for arts and cultural enrichment and as a memorial to their daughter Carolyn. The former church, built in 1903, has been extensively refurbished to a fabulous Gallery and the former church hall has been developed into a state-of-the-art theatre, performance and cinematographic space. The Carolyn Theatre hosts drama, music, voice, dance, performance and film events. The Art Gallery curates 11 exhibitions each year and collaborates with community organisations to host major visual arts events. In addition, workshops are offered to members of the community

in the areas of performance, art, music, environmental concerns and self-awareness.

RRRTAG aims to encourage a diversity of cultural activity and enrichment in the community for all ages and abilities at a low cost, quality venue.

RRRTAG is a totally not-for-profit organization, operating under the governance of a Committee of Management that is responsible for overseeing:

- Organisational aims
- Community involvement
- Financial Sustainability
- General Governance Requirements

Three sub-committees; Film Society, Gallery and Theatre oversee the day to day running of RRRTAG along with the organisation of exhibitions and events - refer to the Film Society, Gallery and Theatre tabs for more details.
